Directions to IMC:

From State College:

Take Rt. 220 North to Route I-80 East (Approximately 14.6 miles)

Follow I-80 East to exit 178, Route 220 North towards Lock Haven (Approximately 17.4 miles)

Follow Route 220 North to I180 West.

From the Maynard Street Exit on I180,

Travel North on Maynard Street (away from the river.) Continue past the entrance to Penn College, across Third Street to the stop sign at the end of Maynard Street. Turn left onto West Fourth Street. The Center for Business & Workforce Development is on the left just beyond the traffic light.

From Williamsport:

Follow Route 180 East to the Maynard Street exit.

Travel North on Maynard Street (away from the river.) Continue past the entrance to Penn College, across Third Street to the stop sign at the end of Maynard Street. Turn left onto West Fourth Street. The Center for Business & Workforce Development is on the left just beyond the traffic light.

From Milton/Lewisburg:

Follow Rt. 147N, which becomes I-180W at I-80.

Continue on I-180W to the Maynard Street Exit.

Travel North on Maynard Street (away from the river.) Continue past the entrance to Penn College, across Third Street to the stop sign at the end of Maynard Street. Turn left onto West Fourth Street. The Center for Business & Workforce Development is on the left just beyond the traffic light.
