## Program Highlights

### **AS9100 Supplier Information Session Abstract**

The AS9100 standard (ISO 9000 based standard created by the leading aerospace companies of the US and World) is complicated to many organizations whose customers mandate them to follow it. The problem is that the communication between suppliers and customers is not always that effective. Thus, the suppliers of the aerospace industry are left in the dark with what they must do to meet the AS9100 standard, what value can be found in having an aerospace quality system, and what other offshoot of the AS9100 standard (AS9003, AS9110, AS9120) is right for them.

The discussion will include: The background of the AS9100 standard from the necessity of its formation to the current status. Also discussed will be the structure a registrar must follow to provide the registration, the other offshoot standards and their applicable markets, and where value can be found for a supplier.

Grant is certified as a provisional Aerospace Auditor with concentrations in AS9100, AS9003, and AS9120.

# QUALITY MANAGEMENT SYSTEM AUDITING COURSE (2-day)

## CLASS MEMBERS WILL BE ABLE TO:

Understand Benefits and Process of Auditing, Interpret the ISO9000:2000 Quality System Standard  
Identify the different Audit Types, Identify the Stages of the Auditing Process, Plan, Prepare for, Conduct and Report on an audit, Prepare and Use Checklists, Recognize **Objective Data**, Write **Nonconformance Records**, Apply for **Auditor Certification** through American Society for Quality (ASQ), and the Registration Accreditation Board (RAB)

## CLASS STRUCTURE:

Class structure includes: lecture, class discussion, exercises, and a case study for audit practice.

## WHO SHOULD ATTEND?

Managers, Quality Managers, Senior Quality Assurance personnel or any employee of a company who is expected to be involved in the company's internal quality audit process. Companies preparing for or intending to qualify for ISO 9000:2000 certification are required to implement such a system.

The course will be held at the Berks Career and Technology Center (BCTC) – West at 1057 County Road, Leesport PA on Wednesday and Thursday April 13th and 14th, 2005. Course will start each day at 8:00am and end at 5:00pm.

**DIRECTIONS TO BCTC - WEST -cont'd on next page**

1. From the east or west via route 78, take exit #19 (Strausstown). Proceed south on route 183 approx. 12 miles to 3rd traffic light. Turn right onto West Leesport Road for approx. ¼ mile to stop sign. Turn right onto County Road. BCTC is the 1st building on the right, (approx. ¼ mile).

2. From the south via route 76, travel west on route 422 toward Reading. Stay on divided highway which is route 222 north. Take route 183 exit and travel north on 183. Proceed north to traffic light (approx 1 mile). Turn left onto West Leesport Road for approx. ¼ mile to stop sign. Turn right onto County Road. BCTC is the 1st building on the right, (approx. ¼ mile).
